



## STATEMENT QUALIFICATIONS

Good: The cat is unsuitable, both for breeding and for show

Very good: The cat is not suitable for showing, but it is suitable for breeding, provided it has a well-selected partner

Excellent: Excellent cat - exhibition specimen.

In all classes, excellent is the highest qualification that can be achieved. This can be divided into U1, U2, etc...

If more cats are presented in a certain class and are too good for the qualification "very good" then they all get excellent = U.

If the cat is now qualified as U1, an additional certificate can also be issued (from the age of 10 months), namely:

CAC CERTIFICAT D'APTITUDE AU CHAMPIONNAT DE BEAUTE.

Can be achieved by all cats in the open class that have achieved U1. Having obtained a CAC three times under 3 different judges entitles you to the title 'champion' = CH.

CAP CERTIFICAT D'APTITUDE AU PREMIORAT DE BEAUTE.

Same as above, but for all cats and males in the castrate class. Entitles you to the title "premier" = PR.

CACIB CERTIFICAT D'APTITUDE AU CHAMPIONNAT INTERNATIONAL DE BEAUTE.

This can be achieved by all cats in the championship class that have obtained a U1. Three times a CACIB, obtained in 2 different countries under 2 different judges entitles you to the title 'INTERNATIONAL CHAMPION' = INT. CH.

CAPIB CERTIFICAT D'APTITUDE AU PREMIOR INTERNATIONAL DE BEAUTE.

Same rules as for the CACIB, but for all females and males in the neuter class Entitles to the title 'INTERNATIONAL PREMIOR' = INT. PR.

CAGCI CERTIFICAT AU GRAND CRAMPIONNAT INTERNATIONAL DE BEAUTE.

Can be achieved by all cats in international champion class that have achieved U1. Three times a CAGCI obtained in 2 different countries and under 2 different judges entitles you to the title 'GREAT INTERNATIONAL CHAMPION' = GR. CH.INT.

CAGPI CERTIFICAT D'APTITUDE AU PREMIOR INTERNATIONAL DE BEAUTE

Same as before, but for all cats and males in the neuter class. 'LARGE INTERNATIONAL PREMIERE' = GR.INT. PR.

## CACE CERTIFICAT D'APTITUDE AU CHAMPIONNAT D'EUROPE DE BEAUTE

This can be achieved by all cats that are already BIG INTERNATIONAL CHAMPION and have achieved U1. Three times CACE obtained in three different countries and under three different judges entitles you to the title 'EUROPEAN CHAMPION' = EUR. CH.

## CAPE CERTIFICAT D'APTITUDE AU PREMIOR D'EUROPE DE BEAUTE

Same as above, but for all males and females in the castrate class. Entitles you to the title 'EUROPEAN PRINCIPAL' = EUR. PR.

## CAGCE CERTIFICAT D'APTITUDE AU GRAND CRAMPIONNAT D'EUROPE DE BEAUTE

Can be achieved by all cats that are already EUROPEAN CHAMPIONS. Four times CAGCE obtained in four different countries entitles you to the title 'GREAT EUROPEAN CHAMPION' = GR. EUR. CH.

## CAGPE CERTIFICAT D'APTITUDE AU GRAND PREMIOR D'EUROPE DE BEAUTE

Same as for CAGCE, but for all females and males in the castrate class. Entitles you to the title 'GROOT EUROPESE PREMIER' = GR. EUR. PR.

## CACM CERTIFICAT D'APTITUDE AU CHAMPIONNAT DU MONDE DE BEAUTE

This can be achieved by all cats that are already BIG EUROPEAN CHAMPION and have achieved U1. Three times CACM obtained in three different countries, including one title on another continent (or judge from another continent) and under 3 different judges entitles you to the title 'WORLD CHAMPION' = W.CH.

## CAPM CERTIFICAT D'APTITUDE AU PREMIORAT DU MONDE DE BEAUTE

Same rules as for the CACM, but for all males and females in the castrate class. Entitles you to the title: 'WORLD PREMIOR' = W.PR.

## HONORARY CLASS:

Only for the cats that are already EUROPEAN CHAMPION or EUROPEAN PREMIOR. The judging in this class is done for the whole class, without distinction of color or sex. They are only divided into longhair, semi-longhair and shorthair.
